


The Election of 1800

- Negative campaigning
- How does TJ beat Adams?
 - Aaron Burr wins NY
 - BUT...tied in Electoral Votes so...
 - Thank you Alexander Hamilton
- 12th Amendment
 - President & VP run together on a ticket

The Revolution of 1800

- Smaller Government
 - Cut taxes, reduced debt, smaller army
- Midnight Judges (pack the court)
 - Marbury v. Madison
 - Judicial Review
- Louisiana Purchase (1803)
 - Lewis & Clark

War of 1812


- Causes:
 - Impressment
 - Indians
 - Tecumseh & the Prophet
 - 1811 Battle of Tippecanoe
- Deeply Divided/unprepared
- 2 Major Battles:
- Washington/Baltimore
 - Star Spangled Banner
- New Orleans
 - Jackson

How did it end?

- Treaty of Ghent (Dec 1814)
- Results
 - Increased nationalism
 - Early industry
 - Death of Federalist Party
 - New respect for nation
 - New heroes
 - Indians gave up land

Foreign Policy

- Rush Bagot (1817)
 - Peaceful border US/Canada
- Florida
 - Jackson
 - Adams-Onis Treaty (1819)
- Monroe Doctrine (1823)
 - Warns Europe:
 - No Colonization
 - No intervention



Growing Country

- American System
 - Strong Banking System
 - Protective Tariffs (1816)
 - Roads & canals
 - States must fund
 - Erie Canal
- 1819 MO statehood
 - MO Compromise
 - MO slave/ME free
 - 36 30 no slaves

Elections of 1824/1828

- Corrupt Bargain
 - Jackson vs. JQ Adams
 - No electoral majority
 - House chooses among top 3
 - Clay: Speaker of House
 - HATES Jackson
- Jackson wins 1828 in landslide
 - Spoils system



- Western Expansion
- Voluntary removal (100,000)
- Indian Removal Act of 1830

Tariff of Abominations

- 1828 increased tariff
 - Believed South was most hurt prices up
- John C. Calhoun NULLIFICATION
- 1832 Force Bill
 - Use military to collect federal tariff duties

The Bank War


- Bank of US
 - Controlled much of US's gold and silver
 - Nicholas Biddle (very powerful)
 - Profit 1st priority
- 1832 election: charter election issue
- 1833 removes deposits
 - Called in loans
 - Moved to pet banks
- 1836 Specie Circular
 - All public lands bough w/ HARD \$\$
 - Crash of 1837


The Birth of the Whigs

- Organized incompatibility
 - Groups opposed to Jackson
- Progressive
 - Government programs & reform
 - Internal improvements
- Market Economy
- Absorbed anti-Masonic
 - Blunted common an appeal

Election of 1836/40

- Whigs: opposed "King Andrew"
- 1836: Martin Van Buren
 - Turmoil & Trouble
- 1840: Van Buren vs. Harrison
 - Manifest Destiny
 - Texas






The Oregon Trail: Bierstadt, 1869



Trails Westward








The Lone Star State

- Independence 1836
 - Remember the Alamo!
 - Sam Houston
- 1845: annexed





Mexican-American War

- James K. Polk (1844)
- Wanted California
 - Mexico refused to sell it
 - WAR!
 - 1848 Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo
